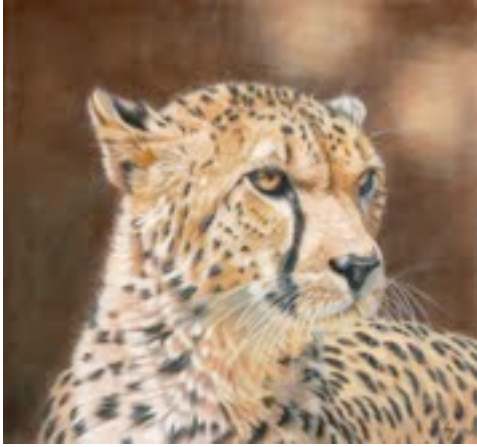


# Nature in Art

### **Course description**

The course will cover types of pastel and papers/boards and how to choose the right one for your project. Safety with pastels and packed with hints and tips on application methods, how to erase and correction methods. The workshop will be in a step-by-step format with the tutor demonstrating methods with insight into how to obtain realistic eyes, noses and fur. Full assistance given throughout the whole weekend plus advice and information to take away.

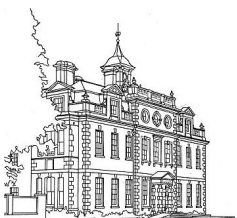
### **Materials**

Pastel paper, pastel pencils and hard (square shaped) pastels. Tracedown paper, scalpel knife or single-sided razor blade for sharpening pencils, HB pencil, small piece of sand paper (the type used for DIY), small stiff paint brush (hog type) or pastel brush, drawing board and table top easel (if required). Glassine paper to protect work – I can supply this at a small cost on the day and a folder to carry work home in.

A more comprehensive materials list will be sent to course participants closer to the time of the course.

### **How to book**

To book onto this course please complete a Nature in Art Course booking form and send to the address at the bottom of this sheet with payment (cheques to be made payable to 'Nature in Art').
