### **Course description**

During this 2-day course you will learn how traditional stained glass is made, by making your own A4-sized panel to one of a number of pre-drawn designs. You will be taught how to cut glass to the shapes determined by the design, then to assemble the panel with lead and finally to solder the panel together and cement it. At the end of the course your panel is yours to keep.

### **Materials**

Please wear old clothes or an apron and wear sturdy shoes. All tools and materials (glass, lead, solder and cement) will be provided by Kim at a cost of £25, payable directly to Kim during the course.

### **How to book**

To book onto this course please complete a Nature in Art Course booking form and send to the address at the bottom of this sheet with payment (cheques to be made payable to 'Nature in Art'). A non-refundable deposit of £20 will secure your place on the course but once booked full payment must be received at least 4 weeks prior to the start of the course (otherwise your place may be offered to another applicant). *Not all courses fill up before the payment date, so please feel free to enquire about availability.*

### **About Kim Berry**

Kim has been working in stained glass for over 12 years, and has undertaken many window and panel commissions for both domestic and commercial premises. He also carries out repairs and restoration work. He works with both lead and copperfoil techniques, and has also been working with "warm glass" - firing glass in a kiln to produce fused pieces.
