Course description

This is a single day workshop aimed at beginners that will introduce them to sketching with pen and wash. The students will be shown how to draw and sketch with an ink pen and how to combine this with painting with a watercolour wash. Topics covered include different textures, shading and using the pen before and after the wash. Using demonstrations and working from photographs supplied by the tutor, the students will be shown how each technique can be achieved and the tutor will be on hand to give group and individual help and critique. By the end of the day the students will have produced a number of small sketches using the exercises learnt during the day.

Materials

- 1 x disposable waterproof pigment ink fibre tip pen size 0.2, 0.3 or 04 (Pilot DR, Edding Profipen or similar)
- 1 x size 10 or 12 round watercolour brush, sable, nylon or sable/synthetic blend.

Students or artists quality watercolour paint;

- At least 1 x tube (or pans) of the following colours:

Ultramarine Blue, Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Red, Burnt Sienna, Raw Sienna.

- 1 x white mixing palette (if using tubes, an old china plate will suffice)

- At least 4 sheets or 1 x pad of 140lb, Not surface (Cold Pressed) watercolour paper (spiral bound is preferable but not essential) approximate size 14 x 10 inches. (1/4 imperial)

- 1 x 2b pencil and eraser

- Tissues and a water container such as a jam jar or similar.

How to book

To book onto this course please complete a Nature in Art Course booking form and send to the address at the bottom of this sheet with payment (cheques to be made payable to 'Nature in Art'). A non-refundable deposit of £20 will secure your place on the course but once booked full payment must be received at least 4 weeks prior to the start of the course (otherwise your place may be offered to another applicant). *Not all courses fill up before the payment date, so please feel free to enquire about availability.*
