Course description

Learn the basics of working with sterling silver; cutting, filing, soldering and polishing, using traditional and modern gold smithing tools and techniques. You will make a simple flower or animal pendant. If time allows you will also make your own clasp by forging silver wire.

Bring any line drawings/tracings of flower or animal pictures for inspiration, although there will be a few options for you to choose from in the class.

All material and tools are provided. This course is suitable for complete beginners.

Bring reading glasses (if worn), an apron or old shirt to cover clothes, notepad & pen/pencil. Note that long hair must be tied back and no open-toe footwear is allowed. All materials will be provided at a cost of £20-30, payable directly to Nicky during the course.
